CLASSES

CLASS 1 NOVICE – Team* & Individual

Horse/Pony any height. All riders must currently be in full time education and may be of any age up to the end of their final year.
Horse/Pony & Rider combination must never have been placed at any BE, Pony Club 'Open' level or similar.
Note: Condition of Entry No.4

Show jumps and cross country fences – approx. 2'6" – 2'9"

CLASS 2 INTERMEDIATE – Team* & Individual

Horse/Pony any height. All riders must currently be in full time education and may be of any age up to the end of their final year.
Horse/Pony & Rider combination must never have been placed in at any BE, Pony Club 'Open' level or similar.
Note: Condition of Entry No.4

Show jumps and cross country fences – approx. 2'9 – 3'0"

CLASS 3 OPEN – Team* & Individual

Horse/Pony any height. All riders must currently be in full time education and may be of any age up to the end of their final year
Note: Condition of Entry No.4

Show jumps and cross country fences – approx. 3'0" – 3'3"

*TEAMS

Teams of 3 or 4, three scores to count. Teams should comprise of pupils from the same school. However, if there are insufficient riders from one school, teams can be made up with riders from different schools with the Entry Secretary's permission. All competitors entered in Teams will automatically count as individuals.

INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES

Individual entries are welcome from schools unable to field a Team.

Riders may only compete on a maximum of 2 horses and no horse may compete more than once.

Team Rosettes:	1st – 6th place in each Class
Trophies:	Individual Winners of each Class/Section & Team Winners of each Class

ABOUT THE COMPETITION

The Competition will be run as follows:

- Phase A: Roads and Tracks
- Phase B: Steeplechase
- Phase C: Roads and tracks
- Phase D: A continuous track of show jumps and cross country fences.

The time allowed for Phases A B & C will be generous as Stop Watches cannot be worn. Only jumping faults and missed gates on the Roads & Tracks will incur penalties. Phase D will be based on an optimum time and run under BE rules.

The course will be designed to reward skilful riding and the competition will be judged on a combination of steeplechase, show-jumping, cross country penalties and a timed section.

The cross country course has been built and designed by Hugh Lochore, an approved FEI course builder, and will provide a variety of cross country fences including a bank, sunken road, water, corners and ditches. The Novice Class will be designed to encourage the less experienced horse/pony and rider combinations.

Distances and timings will be published on www.bloxhamschool.com and www.foxhill-farm.com on Friday 18th September 2009.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The competition will be run in accordance with **BE Rules** except:
 - Riders do not need to have their hat tagged but must comply with Condition of Entry 3 : Hard Hats
 - Riders do not need to be registered with BE
 - Stop watches are strictly forbidden
2. The decisions of the Judges and the Organisers are final. In the event of bad weather / ground conditions the Organisers reserve the right to alter the format to a two phase competition..
3. **HARD HATS MUST** be worn at all times with chinstrap fastened when mounted and must conform to current safety standards. Hats with long ventilation slits are not permitted. **BODY PROTECTORS AND MEDICAL ARMBANDS** must be worn.
4. Riders may only compete on a maximum of 2 horses and no horse may compete more than once.
5. **DRESS CODE:** Cross country colours with correct footwear. Half chaps, black or brown, may be worn with standard riding jodhpur boots of the same colour but no tassels allowed. School Numnahs will be permitted.
6. **RESERVATION OF RIGHT:** The Organisers reserve the right to:
 - a) Cancel the event, in which case entry fees will be refunded
 - b) Ballot in the event of over subscription
 - c) Alter the Show Jumping/Cross Country course if necessary
 - d) Split Classes 1 and 2 into age sections depending on entries.
7. **WITHDRAWALS:** For a full entry fee refund, the Entry Secretary must be notified before the closing date of **Friday, 18th September 2009** - Tel: 01295 760230. After that date, fees will only be refunded on presentation of a veterinary or medical certificate.
8. **OBJECTIONS:** Any objections must be handed to the Chief Steward in writing, with a deposit of £10.00 within 10 minutes of the results being published.
9. **PHOTOGRAPHERS:** Please note that photographs taken by the Official Photographers will appear on their websites and be available for purchase.
10. **DOGS:** Dogs must be kept on a short lead and under control at all times.
11. **LORRY PARK:** Please do not leave horses and ponies unattended in the lorry park.
12. **HEALTH AND SAFETY:** The Organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and **MUST** obey the instructions of the Organisers and the Officials and Stewards.
13. **LIABILITY:** Although every care will be taken, neither the Organisers nor any person acting on their behalf or the Landowners can accept any liability for the loss, damage, accident or injury to persons, horses or property. Competitors take part at their own risk.

PLEASE NOTE: Hats of the correct standard, Body Protectors & Medical Armbands must be worn .
