Entry Procedure: *When a child is registered for entry to Bloxham School, there is a £75 Registration Fee (non-returnable) to cover administration etc. On acceptance of a place, an Entry Fee of £100 is payable. If the Entry Fee has been paid prior to an expected offer of a place, and in the event a place is subsequently not offered, the Entry Fee will be refunded.*

Acceptance Deposit: *The Acceptance Deposit is payable upon acceptance of a place. For UK residents a £500 Acceptance Deposit is payable; for non-UK residents a deposit of a full term's fees is charged. An offer of a place may be made by Bloxham School conditional upon the pupil attaining a specific academic standard. In the event that this standard is not achieved, any Acceptance Deposit will be refunded in full. Acceptance Deposits are ordinarily refunded on the pupil's final bill.*

Overnight stays: The School charges Dayboarders for overnight stays, except when a stopover is required by a School Activity. The charges are:- £35 per night, 4th to 6th Form (£25 in Lower School + 3rd Form) for bed and breakfast.

Instrumental Tuition: 30 lessons will normally be delivered over the course of the academic year. The number of lessons per term varies with the terms' differing lengths, but for convenience one third of the total charge is billed each term. Further details are available from the Music Department.

When pupils intend to cease instrumental lessons, at least half a term's notice must be sent to the Director of Music. If this notice is not received, the tuition fee for the following half term will normally be charged.

Music Scholars and Music Exhibitioners receive tuition on one instrument as part of their Award, at no extra charge.

Private Tuition: According to the number of pupils taken together (1 up to a maximum number of 4) £37.00, £21.00, £16.00 and £13 .00 per hour respectively.

Dyslexia Course: There is a further charge of £1075 per term for full membership of the Dyslexia Course. Dyslexic pupils in the Sixth Form are no longer Course members, although they can continue to receive advice from the Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator. The nature of any regular ongoing support and charges for the pupils who are not members of the Dyslexia Course will be determined on an individual basis.

EFL Course: The membership charge of the EFL Course, for pupils from abroad, for whom English is not their first language, is £1075 per term. This is for 5 to 6 EFL (English as a Foreign Language) lessons a week, taken instead of French. Some pupils from abroad require EFL teaching, but not membership of the Course. The extent and nature of the teaching required will be determined and charged on an individual basis, which shall approximate to the application of the termly rate on a *pro rata* basis.
