#### Great News

Since the last Progress Report went out just before last term, we have broken through the million pound mark. Our current total stands at **£1,065,458.75**. This sum – the largest ever raised in a Bloxham fundraising campaign – is made up of all sizes of gifts, each one truly valued. Hearty thanks to all our donors.

An interesting statistic shows that just 4% of our known Old Bloxhamists have supported the Campaign so far, but these have given a tremendous 26% of the total. Just imagine how magnificent that would be if we could double – or even treble – those figures. Miles Hedges spoke at the Old Bloxhamist day in February and encouraged more support.

#### Great Developments at Bloxham

**The Vallance Library** is up and running and has become very much a part of daily life; the new **6th Form Art Studio** is an important addition and the old Art School is to be brought up to a similar standard and is to be named after its principal sponsor **Old Bloxhamist Aron Harilela**; the **Great Hall** now has its new raked seating and work on the new stage is in progress; the new **Music School Extension** is coming on apace and should be open for the start of the new academic year.

#### Naming Seats

We are offering to recognise all donations of £1000 (approximately £10 per month by 7-year covenant) and above by inviting the donors to name a seat in the Great Hall; many have taken up this opportunity and the plaques will be in place at Founderstide. You will find the plan of the remaining seats enclosed with this mailing. Seats are allocated as the forms are returned.
