

External Examination Period Arrangements 2024:

Upper Sixth

- Lessons up to and including Saturday 18th May
- Previous 2 weeks there will be some disruption for A2 Biology, Business and Economics and possible AS re-sits in Computer Science, Geography and Biology. Students are allowed the morning prior to an afternoon exam to be out of lessons for revision.
- <u>Monday 20th May. Under External Examination period arrangements</u> Teachers to be available during previous timetabled lesson times for supported revision. Students are not required to be in class but may choose to do so.
- Post-half term. Teachers to be available during previous lesson times for supported revision and individual support outside of invigilation commitments.
- Founderstide Saturday 22nd June.
- Exam contingency Day: Wednesday 26th June
- Book Collection Day / House Day: Thursday 27th June.
- Leavers' celebrations: Friday 28th June.

Lower Sixth

- Computing (8.5.24 & 17.5.24), Geography (8.5.24 & 17.5.24), Biology (9.5.24 & 14.5.24), Sport BTEC (2.5.24 & 15.5.24), Business CTEC (14.5.24).
- Internal examination period (UCAS Grade predictor examinations) <u>Monday 3rd June –</u> <u>Saturday 8th June</u>
- Future Focus: Content delivered via Friday 6th Form lecture series.
- <u>University visits / Open Days should be arranged outside of term time (max 2 days in term</u> with Head's permission only.
- Founderstide Saturday 22nd June.

Fifth Form

- Exam period commences on Thursday 9th May
- Lesson structure to continue up to and including <u>Friday 24th May</u> to allow supervised revision. Subject teachers to use professional judgement over own subject revision but none to be done after break if there is an afternoon examination in another subject. In this situation students will choose own revision and plan accordingly.
- From Monday 3rd June. 5th Form timetable is suspended, revision to be supervised in designated supervised classrooms.
- Organise blocks of time during which some subjects may wish to offer structured revision prior to their examination (if no impact on other revision). Students expected to attend these sessions, these to be published to students and parents before half term.
- After lunchtime on **Friday 14th June** Housemaster's may give permission for a student to revise at home if there are large gaps between examinations and if this has been requested by the parents and is in line with the school policy.
- Once a student has completed their examinations, they are to be encouraged to arrange individual work experience which will probably by necessity be from home.
